



# Play Ball With PBI All Week Long

Introducing PBI's most exciting and revolutionary program yet! **PBI Outdoor Summer Games and Camp** runs **Monday through Thursday 9:00AM - 1:00PM** (*Friday is a rain date*). Players will go thru a one day "evaluation/spring training" regimen, and then players will put their skills into action in a full day no inning limit live baseball game for the remainder of the week. PBI coaches will instruct players during the course of the game, and special "skill" areas will be set up to work with players throughout the week. Every player will receive a written evaluation on his skills from a certified PBI "scout" at the conclusion of the week.

Players will have time for a quick lunch each day. PBI does not provide lunch. So please pack a light lunch for your child.

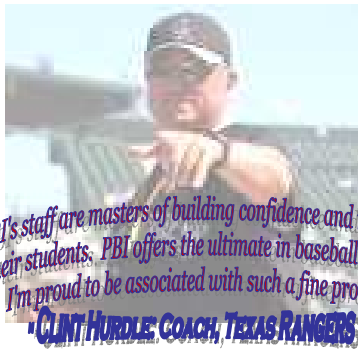

## PICKING THE TEAMS:

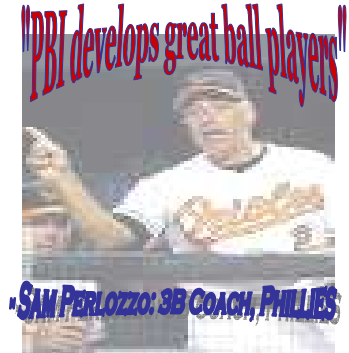
PBI coaches will review the evaluations at the conclusion of Monday's workout and draft their teams. Players will be divided into teams according to their age and skill levels in a number of criteria. Throughout the week players may be traded between teams in order to keep the teams as evenly matched as possible.

**DAY #1-** Monday is evaluation day. Players will be put thru a regimen just as players go thru at a professional scouting camp or spring training. PBI will evaluate and rate players' ability in: Running Speed, Hitting Mechanics, Hitting Skills, Hitting Power, Arm Strength, Arm Accuracy, Fielding Mechanics, Infield Skills, Outfield Skills, and for players whom wish to pitch and/or catch; Pitching Mechanics, Pitching Skills, Catching Mechanics & Catching Skills. At the conclusion of Day 1, PBI coaches will meet to draft their teams for the games on day 2, 3 & 4.

**DAY #2, 3 & 4-** Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday are Game Days.

**9:00- 9:15>** Each morning we will begin with a quick warm up, we will stretch and throw to get loose.

**9:15- 10:15>** We go into our pre-game routine. Players will take ground balls, field fly balls, take Infield/Outfield & Batting Practice.

**10:30- 1:00>** Game Time!!! During the games players will be put into positions according to their evaluations. Depending upon the skill levels of the players, PBI coaches and/or players may pitch (this is so we do not conflict with pitching limitations of players that pitch on their teams, and to keep the game moving so hitters can see good quality pitching). We play as many innings as possible between 10:30 & 1:00; no limit.

**SKILLS TRAINING-** Each morning during the pre-game routine players will be instructed in both defensive and offensive areas of the game. Drill areas will also be set up during the games so players will be able to filter thru a specific drill area and work on their skills. If coaches recognize something in a player during the game he will go off to a drill station and "clean it up". Also, during a team's offensive portion of the inning instead of just sitting on the bench they will rotate thru daily skill areas.

**YOUR EVALUATION-** Every player will receive a written evaluation of their skills from PBI. The evaluation will include all of your ratings from "evaluation day", and coaches will be watching and taking notes all week long. Your evaluation report will be emailed to you on the Monday following the conclusion of your program. Coming to Games Camp multiple weeks? You'll be able to track your progress all summer long!!!

**Confirmation-** Upon registration, you will receive a confirmation packet in the mail, including directions and a health history form.

**Refund Policies-** There are NO cash refunds. Any student missing sessions - regardless of the reason - will be issued a credit voucher minus a \$50 administrative fee. Vouchers have no expiration date, and can be used toward any future PBI clinic or camp program.

**Make-Up Time-** You will be expected to attend the program that you signed up for. PBI cannot guarantee the ability to accommodate changes made after your program has begun. Typically our schedule is full; therefore, making up time may not be possible.

**Weather-** In the event of questionable weather, call 1-800-282-4638 in the morning and press 7 for a recording with weather related updates. In the event the day needs to be cancelled due to weather; we will typically make a decision by 8:15am. On occasion, depending upon the specific situation, we may not make a decision until 9am. Fields must be in good condition to avoid possible injuries.

**Medical & Insurance Info-** PBI provides medical and liability insurance for all players.

**Transportation-** PBI does NOT provide transportation.

**Fees-** Pre-Paid students pay \$249. per week. Our Family Plan allows for a \$10. deduction of the program fee for any additional sibling.

**Late Registration-** Late registrations are accepted the weekend (Sat. & Sun.) prior to the program. We can not guarantee that registrations can be taken the morning of the program as for it may be full. PBI charges a late registration fee of \$25.

**Private Lessons-** Are available after each day's game right at the field! Just call 1-800-282-4638 x100 to set one up.

Available to all age groups. One-on-one instruction from any of our staff members. Private lessons are for those wanting to bring their game to a new level. Cost is \$55. for a 1/2 hour, \$79. for 45 min, and \$100. for 1 hour.

Private lessons are also available year-round at PBI's indoor baseball stadium conveniently located on Rt. 17 North in Upper Saddle River, NJ.
